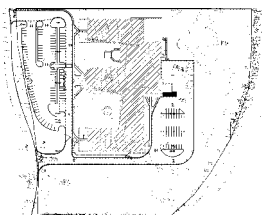

# Goshen Elementary School at Hillcrest Prospect, Kentucky

**G**oshen Elementary School at Hillcrest was designed for 700 students. The building site is located at the entrance of an upscale subdivision, so the design needed to incorporate materials and design elements that would complement the surrounding homes. The challenge was accomplished by the use of brick, precast stone, design elements, and a sloped shingled roof that not only helped the school blend in, by mimicking the surrounding homes, but eliminated costly reroofing expenses found with flat roofs. Two lighted cupolas accentuate the main entrance to the school. Natural lighting was accentuated throughout the school while placing an emphasis on instructional space.

The media center functions as the heart of the school while maintaining all technology from its central networked hub by connecting all classrooms, computer lab, and administration together. While the media center maintains the technology side of the building, it also provides a place that facilitates reading, studying, and instruction.

A fun and easy-to-use wayfinding system was incorporated into the interior design to help new students quickly and comfortably adapt to their new surroundings. This was achieved at the lobby by a giant rainbow that appears on the wall and travels down to the floor, where matching tiles lead one through the corridors to the appropriate classrooms. The school includes a full-size gymnasium with a rock-climbing

wall, art room with kiln, music room, science room, performance stage, cafetorium, teacher resource room, computer lab, and media production facility.

The effect of all of these features is a very uplifting, creative, and safe learning environment that further adds to the already awarded National School of Excellence. ■
