# Shatekon Elementary School

*Clifton Park, New York*

To maximize funding resourcefully, Shatekon Elementary School was designed to connect physically with its sister school while embracing its own identity, educational culture, and mission. To differentiate Shatekon from the adjacent school, the designer created a separate vehicular entrance with controlled access between the two schools.

Shatekon, meaning “balanced life,” includes a beautiful, lofty entrance and atrium gathering space that provides natural daylighting and controlled security access. The media center is centrally located opposite the entrance to the atrium, isolated from the academic wings and accessible for use after hours. Two academic wings distinctly separate the lower grades, K-2, from the higher grades, 3-5.

The gymnasium offers multipurpose and community use and includes a stage area for school performances and activities, as well as public rest rooms. Classrooms are bright and airy, including the colorful kindergarten rooms, which feature a prominent arch at the back of each room and encom-

pass reading and play areas for students. Additionally, there are dedicated art, music, and computer classrooms throughout the building. Shatekon is fully air-conditioned, with a specialized chiller to minimize noise. The school also features energy-efficient light fixtures throughout. ■
